## Q. What attracted you to small cap investing?

A. It's the least exploited part of the marketplace. When you think small, mid- and large cap stocks, small caps tend to have the least analyst covers. There's the least amount of information, and therefore, it's the most exploitable.

If you're correct in making investment decisions on the small cap side, you're going to see the rewards of that—probably greater than what you would see on the large cap or mid-cap side. Likewise, if you make bad decisions on the small cap side, the cost of being wrong is probably higher than what you would see on the large cap side, and I like that.

I like the idea of having my neck on the line and having the decisions I'm making on the small cap side be somewhat exaggerated by the marketplace.
