## OVERVIEW

The Fund primarily invests its assets in a broad range of U.S. dollar-denominated high-yield securities, including bonds (often referred to as "junk" bonds), convertible securities or preferred stocks, with an emphasis on below investment-grade debt securities. Although the Fund will invest primarily in U.S. debt securities, it may invest without limit in dollar-denominated non-U.S. debt securities and to a limited extent in non-dollar-denominated non-U.S. debt securities, including in each case emerging markets debt securities.

In addition, the Fund may invest its assets in equity securities, defaulted securities, non-dollar-denominated foreign debt securities (including emerging markets debt securities), and certain derivatives, such as futures and options. The Fund may use derivatives for hedging and/or efficient portfolio management.

## PORTFOLIO FIT

The fund can complement investment grade credit exposure, providing attractive income and total return potential for more risk-tolerant investors.

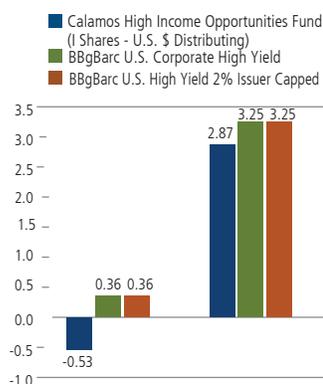

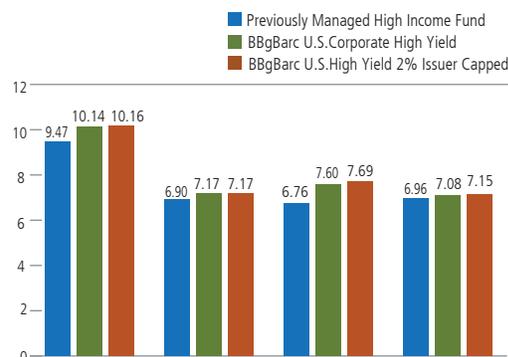
## Fund Objective
